'Plan 2000' proposes new structure for Beta Alpha

The organizational chart above is a proposed structure of Beta Alpha Chapter of Pi Kappa Phi, Inc. that is a result of the "Plan 2000" meetings.

The purpose of this proposed reorganization is to unify the associations and organizations on both the alumni and undergraduate level.

The authority for the running and operation of the house shall be vested with the Board of Overseers, which is comprised of 9 elected trustees that include: President, Vice-President-Housing, Vice President-Planning,

Treasurer, Secretary, Undergraduate Archon, Chapter Advisor, President of the Division of Housing, and the President of the Recognized Alumni Association (NJAA).

Double solicitation to be eliminated by 'Plan 2000'

One of the major purposes of Plan 2000 is to align all of the sub-organizations of our chapter under one parent organization. The Board of Overseers will meet on a quarterly basis with representatives of the other sub-organizations. A major benefit of this is that all fund-raising can be organized through one effort and not several.

As an alumnus of Beta Alpha Chapter, you will not be solicited separately from the Undergraduate Chapter, Housing Corporation, Beta Alpha Scholarship Fund, North Jersey

Alumni Association, and Continuing Alumni Relations (CAR).

Although not all of these organizations currently solicit funds, the potential was there for each group to do so independently. To resolve any confusion that our alumni may have, we are going to simplify our fund-raising efforts.
